To sustain it for the length of a novel The Illuminating Diary of a Professional Lady in which the protagonist, Lorelei Leerecords her flirtatious adventure in prose that "follows the mannerisms of colloquial speech" and suggests innocence or ignorance yet, the critic Elyse Graham observes, "burlesques, in excoriating detail, the vernacular of the American middle class".

A good old fashioned classic that isn't very long, but still enjoyable with suspense. The authors were now identified as the brothers George and Weedon Grossmith. Though in style and subject matter as English as chops, it really is universal. The book ends with a letter from Lupin:
