The mean age of 14 eyes at cataract extraction was 1. All patients underwent bilateral cataract surgery.

The mechanism of primary ACG may be principally related to an anteriorly positioned lens.

Female carriers can be clinically identified solely based on a lens examination. When You Have Cataracts and Glaucoma.

Patients with an IOP of lower than 22 mmHg were followed up with serial examinations. Removal of all lens material and a primary posterior capsulotomy and an anterior vitrectomy will reduce the chances of secondary membrane formation. Since cataracts may already be clouding vision, this may make vision worse.
