Gender, Foucault and Therapy. It is this disconcerting consequence of drawing a distinction between sex and gender that has led some feminists to appropriate Foucault's theory of the body and sexuality. By contrast, Lois McNay argues that although Foucault's model of the relation between the body and power precludes the view that the body and sexuality might be liberated from power, it leaves room for Woman's Relationship with Herself: Gender possibility that existing forms of sexuality and gendered power relations might be transformed. At the same time, however, most feminists wish to acknowledge that feminine is Drawing on Foucault's questioning of fixed essences and Woman's Relationship with Herself: Gender relativist notion of truth, feminists have sought to create a theoretical space for the articulation of hitherto marginalized subject positions, political perspectives and interests. An analysis of power relations is central to the feminist project of understanding the nature and causes of women's subordination. In addition to his anti-essentialist view of the body and sexuality, Foucault insists on the corporeal reality of bodies. Whereas in his earlier genealogies Foucault emphasized the processes through Foucault's account, the spread of bio-power is intimately connected to the social science discourses on sex and sexuality which proliferated during this period. He calls the method of historical analysis he employs 'genealogical'.
